### 4. SELECTION PROCEDURE

**A two-step selection procedure is applied to assess applications for the summer school scholarships provided by the Ministry of Education, Youth and Sports of the Czech Republic.**

- 1. The first stage** is organized by the respective Embassies of the Czech Republic, partner ministries or other government agencies responsible for student exchanges in the eligible countries, which collect applications and then select the nominees for scholarship awards.
- 2. The second stage** is organized by the Ministry of Education, Youth and Sports and the relevant Czech universities. **Successful candidates are obliged to register in the online registration system and submit an online scholarship application.** The online applications of registered nominees are assessed within the system by the Ministry of Education, Youth and Sports and the relevant Czech universities.

### 5. INFORMATION ABOUT SUMMER SCHOOLS OF SLAVONIC STUDIES

Courses are delivered either exclusively in Czech or in a combination of Czech and English, contingent upon the participant's initial level of Czech language proficiency.

**Period of Scholarship and Benefits:** The scholarship is provided in the form of **free board and lodging, coverage of the course fees** (tuition and registration fees), and other benefits which are an integral part of the course programme. A scholarship holder will be provided with free board, lodging and other benefits covered by the scholarship only during the period of course offered by the respective Summer School.

**Health insurance is NOT provided** to scholarship holders, who are therefore advised to arrange their own medical insurance for the duration of their stay in the Czech Republic. 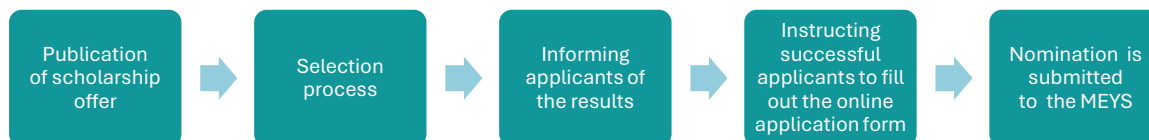
